Contact with COVID-19 by cleaners	Caretaker Contract Cleaner Volunteer helpers	 Disposable gloves to be worn when cleaning. Face masks and aprons to be worn when cleaning after suspected case of COVID-19. Cleaners follow PHE COVID-19: Cleaning in non-healthcare settings guidance where contamination is suspected. Volunteers over 70 or in a vulnerable group will not assist with cleaning. Contract Cleaner advised to change/launder outer clothing after cleaning duties.
